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SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

We recommend that you read the following instructions carefully, before using the appliance.

- 1. Check if the voltage indicated on the base of the appliance, corresponds to the local electrical mains voltage before you connect the appliance.
- 2. Before using the cooker for the first time, remove the scoop, measuring cup and packing material.
- 3. Wipe the bottom and sides of pan before placing it on the heater.
- 4. Take extra care while handling the cooker when the cooking pan has hot liquids in it.
- 5. Prevent insects from entering the electrical portion of the cooker by keeping it clean.
- Make sure that the pan is placed properly in the cooker. If the pan is not
 positioned correctly, the switch may click off too soon or heater may be
 damaged. (Your rice cooker has been designed with a thermal fuse
 which may shut the heater off in these cases.)

Note: Cooking will not start until pan is placed properly in the cooker.

- 7. Be sure the switch is off before removing the pan.
- 8. Do not allow water to reach thermostat or heating plate.
- 9. Do not immerse the body of the rice cooker in water or any other liquid.
- 10. Do not use the cooker if the cooking pan is dented or damaged.
- 11. Do not attempt to repair the rice cooker yourself. Please contact USHA Care at Toll Free No. 1800 1033 111.
- 12. Do not cook more than the maximum capacity in the cooking pan; It could cause spill over during boiling.
- 13. Do not tilt the rice-cooker on its edge or place it upside down with its power supply plug connected, as this may cause damage.

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OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Measure the rice using the measuring cup.
- 2. Wash the rice in another bowl until the water becomes relatively clear.
- 3. Place the cooking plate inside the bowl. Put washed rice into the bowl. Add water as per general guidelines for rice preparation. You may add or reduce the amount of water depending on your personal taste.
- 4. Set the bowl inside the rice cooker.

Note: No foreign matter can be allowed between inner pot and electric heating plate.

- 5. Close the lid in place.
- 6. Plug in and switch On.
- 7. Press the switch. The cooking indicator lights up, indicating cooking has started.
- 8. When rice cooking is done, the switch will pop up & cooking indicator will switch off while the keep warm indicator will start to glow indicating that the keep warm function is working.
- 9. After the switch pops up, leave the lid covered for at least 15 minutes to steam the rice.
- 10. Unplug after use by grasping the plug and not by holding the cord. 11. Please do not use metal spoon as it may damage the appliance. Note: When filling the bowl with rice, the attached spoon should be used to avoid scuffing the coating of inner pot and causing exfoliation of coating at the same time.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR RICE PREPARATION

One cup of uncooked rice makes approximately 3 cups of cooked rice.

Rice should be level with the brim of the measuring cup.

KEEP WARM FUNCTION:

- After cooking is completed "keep Warm" Function automatically starts until the cord is unplugged.
- Always unplug power cord before taking the pan out of the cooker.
- Do not switch to cooking again during "keep warm" function.
- Do not Keep rice in Keep Warm model for more than 4 hours
- Do not use keep warm function to reheat cold rice.

HOW TO USE THE STEAMER

- Add water as desired into the bowl (inner pot) and place the bowl inside the rice cooker.
- 2. Place the steamer on top of the bowl. Place the food you wish to steam inside the steamer. (Place the food in a dish if required.)
- 3. Cover the rice cooker with the lid.
- 4. Plug in the power cord and press the switch. The cooking indicator lights up, indicating cooking has started.
- 5. Time the cooking manually.
 - a. The rice cooker will automatically switch to keep WARM mode when the water evaporates.
 - b. Please note that the food will continue to cook in Keep Warm mode.

NOTE: ALWAYS ENSURE THERE IS WATER IN THE PAN DURING STEAMING

- 6. Turn OFF the rice cooker when the steaming is finished.
- Remove the food, then the steamer and finally take out the bowl and pour out the water.

Tips:

- Grease the inner surface of bowl with ghee or oil to prevent food from crusting or sticking to the bottom of the bowl/pan.
- For foods that tend to crust easily (like rava, khichdi etc.) grease the inner surface with ghee or oil before putting the ingredients in it.
- The taste of the rice will depend on the quality of rice and soaking time before cooking.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Wash the Bowl, Steamer, Trivet plate, Ladle & Cup in the warm soapy water or use mild liquid detergent.
- Do not use metallic sharp spoon or abrasive substance as it will damage the coating of the bowl.
- COOKER Wipe with a clean damp cloth. Donot immerse the cooker in water. Do not allow water to enter thermostat.
